The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage a young woman who meets the scholarship criteria and demonstrates an ambition to continue her study in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics.

To encourage this the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc, is awarding a post graduate scholarship of \$2000 p.a, to be awarded to a female student who has completed a degree at Otago University and is wishing to undertake post graduate study, or graduate study combined with a research project.

The scholarship may be awarded for a maximum of three years, provided that the scholarship winner continues to be enrolled in their chosen study and can provide evidence of her academic success at the completion of each year's study.

The scholarship winner is required to provide evidence of enrolment and end of year results in their chosen course to the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin prior to the scholarship continuing.

Applicants:

- Must be a New Zealand Citizen or a Permanent Resident of New Zealand
- Must have an active commitment to volunteerism
- Should have knowledge of the programmes of Zonta International

Should be an active supporter of advancing the status of women

Application Requirements

- Completion of this official application form
- Two references in support of your application, one of whom should be academic and the other from a voluntary or community organisation the applicant is involved with
- Verification of study at Otago University

Application Process

- All applications must be received by the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc.
- Applications are to be emailed to <u>metropolitandunedin@zonta.org.nz</u>
- Deadline: 10 December each year.
- Scholarship commences at the beginning of the academic year following application.

Evaluation Process

The Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc, STEM Scholarship is a merit–based competitive scholarship.

A panel will consider all applications considering the eligibility criteria. The final evaluation may include an interview and presentation to members of the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin
